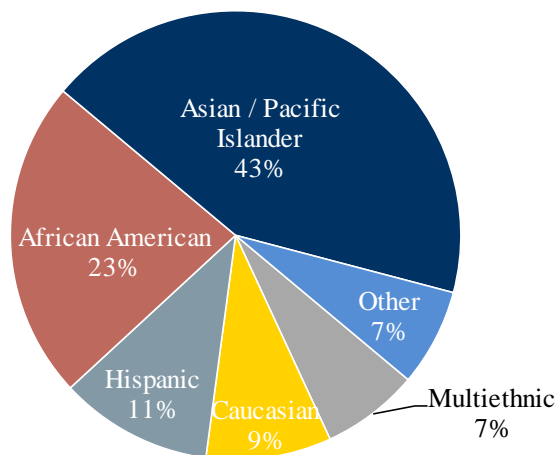

Since 1992, The Municipal Forum of New York has sponsored the Urban Leadership Fellows (“ULF”) Program to place New York City high school graduates in summer internships in the field of municipal finance. To date, 730 interns have participated in the program and a number of these interns have gone on to successful careers in municipal finance.

On behalf of the Municipal Forum’s Youth Education Committee, we are seeking governmental, not-for-profit and for-profit host sites for summer 2019. Once again, we are partnering with Futures and Options, a non-profit organization that works on behalf of the ULF, to identify motivated and high-achieving students who have been accepted into college from New York City public and parochial schools. The cost of hosting an intern is only \$3,875 (including FICA and Medicare Tax) for the 6-week program, which begins July 2, 2019. The Municipal Forum pays the full expense directly for governmental intern sponsors and will reimburse half the expense for not-for-profit intern sponsors.

Summer 2018 was another successful year with 41 participating organizations sponsoring 43 interns. We are proud of the opportunities that the program has offered to worthy New York City high school graduates. Last year, 66% of the interns qualified for the free National School Lunch Program offered by the Department of Agriculture. 2018 ULF Interns




We hope to expand last year’s success by increasing the number of participating intern hosts. Placements will be confirmed on a first-come, first-served basis so we encourage interested hosts to make your commitment as soon as possible. Futures and Options has begun the interview process and we would like to know by April 1 if an entity will host an intern. While it is a less preferred approach, we recognize that logistics and/or location may prevent an entity from hosting an intern. If that is the case, we ask that the organization consider a donation to the Municipal Forum Youth Education Fund in the amount equal to a host’s financial commitment.
